

District of Columbia Court of Appeals – April 2006

Reams v. US, No. 03-CF-1116 (DC 4/6/06): The DCCA held that trial court's exclusion of parts of defendant's hearsay statement to police in murder case was harmless and not plain error.

Blackson v. US, No. 06-CO-103 (DC 4/6/06): The DCCA REVERSED a pretrial detention order, because trial court's finding of dangerousness was not supported by clear and convincing evidence.
