

The DCCA decided only one criminal case last Thursday:

Williams v. US, No. 03-CF-569 (DC 8/18/05): On retrial, DCCA affirmed convictions for armed murder II, ADW, etc., holding: (1) no Brady violations; (2) prior recorded testimony from first trial admissible, though witness unavailable because deported by government; (3) no abuse of discretion in refusal to sanction prosecution for destruction of gun used by drug rival turned "snitch."
