

The DCCA decided three criminal cases today:

(1) *Washington v. US*, No. 00-CF-613 (DC 8/25/05): The DCCA affirmed, despite claim that trial court's letting jury see defendant up close for first time during jury deliberations was "new evidence."

(2) *Brown v. US*, No. 01-CF-1259 (DC 8/25/05): The DCCA affirmed, despite alleged errors in jury instructions and admission of prior consistent statements.

(3) *Bradley v. US*, No. 04-CO-188 (DC 8/25/05): The DCCA affirmed denial of a second 23-110 motion without a hearing; defendant had entered a guilty plea.
