

The DCCA decided two criminal cases today:

(1) *Williams v. US*, No. 04-CM-1089 (DC 12/15/05): The DCCA remanded an assault case with instructions, because it was unable to determine whether or not the evidence was sufficient.

(2) *US v. Jenkins*, No. 05-CO-333 (DC 12/15/05): In a government interlocutory appeal, the DCCA reversed a ruling denying the introduction of DNA evidence against the defendant; the particular DNA methodology was consistent with *Frye* and *Porter*, because it was generally accepted in the scientific community.
