

- (1) Stroman v. US, No. 04-CM-495 (D.C. 7/14/05): Ct. affirmed simple assault (no self-defense) but reversed att. PPW(b) because "flip flop" is not dangerous weapon.
- (2) Stancil v. US, No. 03-CM-444 (D.C. 7/14/05): Rehearing en banc is granted; case is consolidated with 03-CM-605; en banc argument(s) scheduled for October 2005.
- (3) Joseph v. US, No. 99-CF-979 (D.C. 7/14/05): Record remand ordered for evidentiary hearing on 23-110 motion; direct appeals are stayed.
- (4) Griffin v. US, No. 04-CM-849 (D.C. 7/14/05): Motion to suppress tangible evidence and statements properly denied, because Terry stop did not rise to level where Miranda warnings are required.
