

The DCCA decided three criminal cases today:

(1) Dunne v. US, No. 03-CM-1542 (DC 11/17/05): The DCCA held (1) there was sufficient evidence of simple assault, and (2) there was no substantial prosecutorial misconduct (unauthorized practice by law student second chair for AUSA).

(2) Duckett v. US, No. 03-CM-1462 (DC 11/17/05): The DCCA REVERSED, holding that marijuana should have been suppressed because a traffic stop of car was not justified by anything under the Fourth Amendment.

(3) Cullen v. US, No. 04-CM-1105 (DC 11/17/05): The DCCA held that two of the defendant's convictions for sexual abuse merged, because they were part of a continuous course of conduct.
