

The DCCA decided only one criminal case today:

Adams v. US, No. 03-CF-145 (DC 9/8/05): The DCCA affirmed Adams' conviction for armed second degree murder, holding: (1) ID's of two eyewitnesses from photo arrays were not unduly suggestive; (2) any error in limiting cross-examination re drug use was harmless; (3) no plain error in failure to exclude testimony re Adams' carrying of same gun two years earlier; (4) the evidence was sufficient to support the conviction.
